JURISDICTION

Held under the rules of the ACU as laid down in the current handbook/s, the Standing Grass Track regulations and these supplementary regulations, plus any final instructions that may be issued

ELIGIBILITY

Competitors must hold a current annual competition licence issued by the ACU or the Scottish ACU, and be a registered member of a club affiliated to the ACU. A one-day licence can be issued by us, the organising club, for any competitors who may need one. Please contact Carl Pugh (details above) beforehand if you will require a one-day licence (£20 each)
Don't forget to mark your entry form and to include the total in the amount required

INSURANCE

The cover for this meeting is ACU Premier. Please note we, JCR Promotions GTC, strongly recommend that all competitors take out their own additional personal insurance

MACHINES

All machines must comply with the 2024 ACU regulations, and must be kept in the paddock/pits competition area at all times except when racing

SIGNING ON & TECHNICAL INSPECTION

8.30am approx–10.30am approx. The parent or guardian of any entrant under 18 must also sign on before they can take part

PRACTICE

Practice 10.30am-11.15am approx. Practice is compulsory, all riders must complete two laps
Practice Starts are at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
